Christ Will Rise! (no matter where we are)

The Church has left the building, but worship of the Living God continues! Each Sunday, we are sending out a worship-at-home kit by email that includes the prayers and reflections of our various lay leaders, along with the sermon in video and manuscript form, and occasional other videos as feasible. We encourage everyone to choose a different "worship buddy" each week, and go through the service together over the phone.

HOLY WEEK

During Holy Week, we invite you to join us on Zoom (see page 2), for daily readings of the Passion Stories from each gospel. We will hold these Tuesday-Friday (April 7-10) at 1:30 & 6:30. Each person who participates will have the option to read or just listen. Tuesday will be Matthew, Wednesday, Mark, etc.

On Holy Thursday, a short video with a special communion service for you to worship along with will be sent out to everyone as well.

On Easter Sunday, we will celebrate the Risen Christ, even as the Body of Christ remains scattered. We will remember that the first disciples discovered the resurrection in small groups, hidden behind locked doors. We will learn new ways to experience the abundant life Christ offers!

JOIN US ON ZOOM!

After experimenting with using conference calls as a way of connecting for meetings, we have taken the plunge and gotten an account with Zoom, so that we can see each other's faces for our various gatherings. You may have heard of teachers using Zoom to connect with their students, and some churches are using it for worship. We will be using it for meetings and fellowship opportunities.

You can use Zoom with video from your computer, but you can also call into any "gathering" from your regular telephone. If you want to use video, go to zoom.us and click "join a meeting". It will prompt you to download the Zoom app onto your computer. It should help you check to make sure you have all the right settings on. You will need to allow Zoom to use your computer's camera and microphone, so we can see & hear you.

For most of our meetings, we will be using the same Meeting ID with no password, so please don't post it on social media and only share it with VLMers. (There have been reports of hackers disrupting open meetings like this.) The Meeting ID is available on request. Once you have the app downloaded, you can just go to zoom.us, click "join a meeting", and you should be sent directly into our "meeting room". If you want to join by telephone, call 720-707-2699 and then enter the Meeting ID and the # sign. If you want to use our Zoom meeting room for a small group gathering, please check with Pastor Rebecca first, to ensure your preferred time is available.

We invite you to join us for a **Zoom coffee hour** on Wednesday, April 1, at 11:00 am and/or 6:00 pm. This will just be an informal time to see each other's faces and catch up on how we're all adapting to these strange times. Once we've tried that out, we will make decisions about future "coffee hours" and let everyone know in our regular weekly emails. Check the April calendar for other meetings.

Living Our Promises

As a congregation, we are doing everything we can to stay connected during this time. As members of the Body of Christ, we have taken on special responsibility for one another. If you have extra financial burdens during this time, please contact Pastor Rebecca. If you can donate a little extra to the Pastor's Discretionary Fund to help your neighbors, please do so.

We are counting on everyone to keep up your financial support of our congregation, as you are able. You can do that online at www.vlmcc.org/ministries/stewardship or by mailing your gifts to the church. (We are getting the mail more or less every other day.) We will be receiving much less rental income than we usually do, so we will likely be dipping into our reserve funds as well. We have committed to paying our staff for their regular hours, so as not to cause hardship for any of them. (Church employees are not eligible for unemployment insurance.)

We have postponed our annual stewardship campaign for at least a month, so we will creating a budget based on our best analyses of giving thus far this year. We give thanks for your faithful generosity in the coming weeks and months!

Once we are able to resume our regular, face-to-face Bible studies, we will pick up where we left off in our study of Acts. In the meantime, we urge every member of the Vista La Mesa Christian Church community to spend at least ten minutes a day reading scripture.
