#### **Tesa Hauser, Ministerial Assistant!**

During their meeting on May 20, the General Board of VLMCC approved a new position and hired Tesa Hauser to fill it. The position of Ministerial Assistant is underwritten by the Scholarship Fund. Tesa will be working approximately 12 hours per week.

The job summary for this position reads "to serve in a general ministerial capacity, with particular responsibility for enhancing the church's social media presence and working with youth. This position is an investment in the congregation's commitment to cultivating growth and vitality in ministry and membership." Tesa will take part in worship leadership and work closely with our Ministry Committees as well.

We are happy to be able to hire Tesa in this capacity now that she has graduated with her Master of Divinity degree and continuing to pursue ordination with the Pacific Southwest Region.

## From My View at the Table

Dear Church,

As we continue our journey through this season of stressful uncertainty, it is important to recall what we know with assurance: God is love. God is with us. The good news of Pentecost is upon us: the Church is anywhere and everywhere!

As you have heard, the Governor and the County have now allowed churches to gather for worship, with some strict safety guidelines. Our leaders have been discussing the process of reopening extensively and have decided to move slowly for now. We want to see what happens and which best practices emerge as most effective. We do not want to gather again before a good slice of the congregation is ready to come. We want to be as prepared with plans and procedures as possible and take enough time to communicate them to everyone before we open up.

Our Board also clarified that we want to prioritize immediate usage of the building for the 12-step groups that usually meet at VLM. Their need to gather is more important than our desire to be together again. We will be sharing careful guidelines with them in the next few days, to welcome them back with some practical adjustments. Some of our small groups may begin meeting at the church again as well, often outside.

Worship, however, is our most risky activity, with the most people breathing a lot in one room. We want to protect our most vulnerable members. I recognize that it is a spiritual challenge to self-identify as "vulnerable", but it is something all of us will face sooner or later. Please let me know if you are feeling pressured to show up before you are comfortable doing so. We will be sending out a survey soon, aiming to get a sense of your feelings and choices regarding the many questions involved with re-opening.

In the meantime, we will be scheduling some pick-up days very soon, for you to come by the church to get a VLM care package. Home deliveries will also be available. We hope everyone will get one. Watch for more information!

## ZOOM TIPS

You can use Zoom from a computer or from your telephone. From your phone, you will only be able to hear people. From your computer, you'll be able to see people (but you can choose not to have your video on, if you're "not fit for public" at the moment). If you haven't tried it yet, we hope you will, as it is proving very helpful in keeping our community connected!

If you haven't already updated your computer with Zoom 5.0, you will need to do that before you'll be able to join our gatherings after May 30. Go to zoom.us/download to get the update. If you try to join a meeting after 5/30, you will be prompted to get the update; just follow the instructions as they appear.

There are multiple ways to connect to a Zoom gathering. Contact Pastor Rebecca for the one-click link, if that is easiest for you.

Or click "Join a Meeting" at zoom.us and enter our Meeting ID and our password. Or call 720-707-2699 or 669-900-9128 on your phone and enter the Meeting ID when prompted, followed by the # sign. Contact Pastor Rebecca for the Meeting ID and the password, if you need them.

Pro Tip: Find "Gallery View" in the top right corner, and use it instead of "Speaker View". You'll see everyone at once, instead of just the person talking.
