All Saints Memorial Service

We hope you will join us in worship on Sunday, November 7th, as we hold our annual All Saints Memorial Service. This is an important time for us to remember all those we have lost – in the past year and before that. Grief is not something that ever goes away, so we take this chance to open the parts of our hearts where we hold our sorrows to the healing love of God.

While we have only lost one church member this year, we know that many have lost extended family members, and that our whole society and world have been enveloped in grief as we've moved through the pandemic. We will have a special commemoration in this year's All Saints Service for all those who have lost their lives to the coronavirus.

There may be someone you know who really needs to be here for this service. It could be a great blessing for you to invite them.

BIBLE STUDY ON THE GOSPEL OF JOHN

We will be finishing up our Bible Study on the gospel according to John this month. On 11/7, Tesa Hauser will lead discussion on chapters 16 & 17; on 11/14, Marianna Kirwan will cover chapters 18 & 19; and then on 11/21, Pastor Rebecca will conclude our class with an exploration of chapters 20 & 21. It's never too late to join the conversation! The previous sessions are all available on YouTube as well.

Beginning on 11/28, as Advent begins, we will do a four-session study of some of the imagery for Jesus that is found in John. Even though this gospel doesn't have a traditional birth narrative, John has a lot to say about the arrival of Jesus in the world and what it means for us.

Dear Church,

Ten years is a long time! I wish we could re-create the rain that Todd & I brought with us when we arrived in November 2011, because we could definitely use it now.

A lot has changed in the ten years I've been here at Vista La Mesa. People have come, and others have moved on. New ministries have been launched; some have become part of who are are, while others only lasted for a short season. This change and growth is part of what it means for a church to be alive.

We often want to think of "our church" as something unchanging that we can count on. But that's not how life works for human institutions.
