There is a strong possibility that the Interfaith Shelter Network will decide to pull the plug due to rising covid numbers and put guests in hotels instead, in which case, we will hold a fundraising campaign to help with that.

But assuming Shelter is happening at VLM, we'd love to have your help! On 1/15, we'll be having a work day to clear out some of our various rooms and storage spaces to prepare. From My View at the Table

Dear Church,

A year ago, as we entered into the season of Epiphany, the pandemic was approaching its one-year mark and vaccines were beginning to be distributed. Having noted that both "apocalypse" and "epiphany" mean "revelation," it seemed like it might be a good time to reflect on what we had learned from going through a global epidemic. As the pandemic waned and faded from memory, surely there were learnings we didn't want to lose?

At some point, well into this reflection project, Board Chair Julie Germain mentioned to me that she wasn't really able to engage with the questions because it felt too soon. While we definitely collected some interesting thoughts, it turned out Julie was right. The pandemic was not waning; there were (and are) many more months of learning opportunities to come.

Hard as it has been, it seems we've begun to let go of the hope that we'll be able to see the end of the pandemic coming. At this point, it feels like we may only recognize that it ended after the fact. Some, of course, have been trying to pretend it's over for months, simply because they're weary of the safety precautions that will actually make the end come sooner.

So this Epiphany, I propose we focus on a different sort of revelation. Let's be like Ebenezer Scrooge and resolve to carry Christmas with us all year. Let's seek to watch, every day, for signs of Emmanuel. We're living, as we're all tired of hearing, in "unprecedented times." Where do you see God with us in this strange and challenging period of history? What can we learn about God by watching how God shows up in such unusual circumstances? How can you be a sign that God is with us in the midst of such difficulty?

If we're no longer hanging our hopes on leaving the pandemic behind sooner rather than later, let us hang our hopes instead on God, the everlasting presence of Love that will not leave us.
