From My View at the Table

Dear Church,

Time has gotten pretty weird over the past two and a half years. Days and months have run together. Things that happened last year seem like they might have been last month. And the "before times" are hard to remember at all.

A new way to orient our thoughts around time might be a welcome distraction from this confusion. And we've got one on the horizon, as we begin to think about how to celebrate the milestone of 75 years in ministry at the corner of Massachusetts and Boulevard.

There is always the danger, when celebrating anniversaries, of putting too much focus on the past, rather than giving the future the energy it needs and deserves. It feels pretty impossible to imagine the year 2098, a whole 75 years later. But could we spend this milestone year thinking about the next five? Or twenty-five?

For now, the main thing is to consider 2023, and how we might be intentional in this anniversary year about reflecting on what God has done, is doing, and will do with and through our beloved congregation over the years. I can even imagine that focusing on those celebrations might help us more firmly root ourselves in the present moment, in ways that might bring back some clarity about not just what day it is, but where we are in history.

Board News & Committee Appointments

The Board met in July to begin the new ministry year. The Board this year includes Chair Julie Germain, Vice-Chair Karen Cliffe, Secretary Jenny Angione, Trustee Susan Peterson, Treasurer Larry Knight, Personnel Director Mary Jane Fay. Elders Chair (pending) Steve Bridwell, Deacons Chair (pending) Mary Alynn Fallon, Worship Chair Brenda Rorie-Baety, Christian Education Chair Helene Sisneros, Fellowship Chair Beckie Neely, Property Chair John Lehton, Memorial Endowment Chair Jennefer Lehton, and Pastor Rebecca Littlejohn. The position of Outreach Chair is currently vacant. (There are also 3 Deacon slots vacant.)

Financial reports for the fiscal year that ended on June 30th, showed us in a solid financial position, with a year-todate deficit of less than \$5000. Of the \$12,000 that the Board was authorized by the congregation to withdraw from the Memorial Endowment Fund to offset expenses, only \$3000 was withdrawn. Offerings and rental income were both higher than projected.

The Board approved the Chair's appointments of Ray Adsit and Susan Peterson to three-year terms on the Memorial Endowment Committee. The other members are Tim Cliffe, Matt Hauser, Jennefer Lehton, and Helene Sisneros.

The members of the Pastoral Relations Committee and the Associate Pastor Support Committee were also affirmed. PRC: Renee Bridwell (chair), Jenny Angione, Daniel Cliffe, Cheryl Davis-Plotts, and Michael Lewis. APSC: Karen Cliffe (chair), Steve Bridwell, Mandy Dohring, Mary Jane Fay, and Eliseo Sisneros. These two committees operate with one-year terms without term limits. They are intended to provide a space for supportive feedback and reflection on ministry within our congregation.
