John chapter 15 is one of my favorites for its nuggets of wisdom and comfort. The disciples are worried. Jesus keeps talking about leaving, and they don't want him to leave. It's partially about missing Jesus and fear of what will happen when he's not around. Fear about what others might do, and fear if they'll know what to do when Jesus isn't there to lead them anymore.

Lately, we've been looking at different translations of scripture, and I think it's a great idea for this particular section. I have two versions of John 15:16-17 below. Read the versions I provided and others if you have a chance, and reflect on the ways Jesus has called you to be a part of the body of Christ. When we are uncertain, we can turn to Jesus for guidance.

"You did not choose Me but I chose you, and appointed you that you would go and bear fruit, and that your fruit would remain, so that whatever you ask of the Father in My name He may give to you. This I command you, that you love one another. (NASB)

"You didn't choose me, remember; I chose you, and put you in the world to bear fruit, fruit that won't spoil. As fruit bearers, whatever you ask the Father in relation to me, he gives you. But remember the root command: Love one another." (MSG)


