Stewardship Note

At the November Board meeting, we learned that we ended the month of October with a General Fund deficit of just over \$16,000. This is a rather bleak financial situation, and one we haven't been in for some time, even at this point in the year.

We have the sense that it is getting better, so the Board voted to withdraw only the preapproved \$2500 from the Memorial Endowment Fund for now. We will check the numbers again after December 10th and see if it is necessary to withdraw more money at that point.

If you are behind in your intended giving for this fiscal year, this would be a great time to get caught up. Our offerings as of 10/31 were only at 65% of projections. Expenses are slightly over-budget, mostly because of timing issues. Thank you for your generous and faithful contributions!

Volunteer Roles for 2024

If you're looking for a way to deepen your spirituality through service, there are some volunteer roles we could use some help with going into 2024. We really need a couple more tech volunteers in worship, to help with AV and/or Zoom. We could also use some more greeters for before worship and some more offering counters for after worship.
