#### A Lenten Reflection on What's Next

Our culture suggests that a frenetic and very early start on important holidays is best. Ending our celebrations quickly is standard, too. For instance, before Thanksgiving a Christmas season arrives in our stores. To preserve the spirit of the season I resolved to stop going into any retail store as soon as I heard Christmas music (gas and groceries the exception). The retail Christmas has essentially replaced the sacred observance. A minority of us hold Christmas for 12 days until January 6th.

Christ's resurrection has been similarly treated. Easter bunnies, eggs, butterflies abound. Seems an empty tomb doesn't sell well. What does sell speaks of fertility and nature's resuscitation. In the rush to capture Easter our friends head in the opposite direction- chocolate bunnies, egg hunts, and releasing butterflies. For them Easter is a day. Then it's off to the next celebration. Yet, Easter has just begun. Few know or care that Easter lasts 50 days and ends at Pentecost.

On Ash Wednesday we turned our attention to the truth that most would rather avoid; that we will die. For me, the Easter season is a chance to unlearn our fear of death. In it we embrace the promise of God. The resurrection of Jesus helps us fully live before death. Life after death is promised too, but Christian faith is about fullness of life on either side of the grave.

From God we have come. To God we shall return. Between birth and death is God. Try and buy or sell that! The marketplace may substitute symbols of resurrection with signs off resuscitation, but I think we know better than to be sucked in.

At the very end of this month, we will celebrate the resurrection as we do every Sunday at the Lord's table. In what remains of Lent I wish you a transformative maturing of that gift God gives in a daily supply - faith. May your participation in the work of the Resurrected One cause us to pause, savor, reflect, and then move at the pace of God.
